OFFICER'S NARRATIVE

On 02/23/21, I worked uniformed patrol as 2A11 in the City of Moorpark in a marked black and white patrol vehicle. At approximately 1621 hours, I responded to [REDACTED], reference a violation of elder or dependent adult abuse restraining order investigation. Dispatch further advised, (V) [REDACTED] Villanueva had an active elder or dependent adult abuse restraining order against his brother, (A) Salvador Villanueva, and that Salvador was currently at the residence. Sergeant Ponce and Senior Deputy Valdez responded to assist.

It should be noted, I knew Salvador from prior law enforcement contacts and was aware of the active restraining order [REDACTED] had against him. The restraining order stated Salvador must stay 100 yards away from [REDACTED]'s residence, located at [REDACTED].

Upon arrival, I observed Salvador walk out of the front door of the residence. At the time, Sergeant Ponce was at the front gate and told me to go around the west side gate to contact Salvador. I entered the property through the side gate and a female subject, who we later identified as (A) Jeanette Villanueva (Salvador's daughter), told me I needed to leave the property because we were not welcome.

I told Salvador to come towards me, but he stated he was in the process of moving and walked back into the residence. Sergeant Ponce and I immediately entered the residence through the front door and contacted Salvador who was in the living room. I heard Salvador yell, "What", at Sergeant Ponce in an aggressive manner. Salvador then began moving backwards towards the hallway. I continuously told Salvador to "come here", but he refused and told me to sit down. I then attempted to grab Salvador's right wrist, but he quickly pulled it away from my grasp and continued to walk backwards down the hallway.

I grabbed the front of Salvador's flannel shirt and pulled him towards me to prevent him from backing further down the hallway. When I pulled Salvador towards me I grabbed ahold of his left arm and began escorting him towards the front door. When I began escorting Salvador, I felt him tense his left arm and push his weight backward towards me. To prevent Salvador from escaping my grasp, I turned the front of his body toward the couch in the living room and forced him down onto this stomach and onto the couch. I felt Salvador push upward towards me, so I placed my left hand on the right side of his head and pressed it up against the couch to hold him down.

While I was holding Salvador down, I felt Jeanette grab my left arm. I told Jeanette to let go of me and to back up. Jeanette complied, but continuously argued with Sergeant Ponce. Refer to Sergeant Ponce's supplemental report for further details.

I continuously told Salvador to put his hands behind his back, but he tucked his arms underneath his body and refused to comply. I was able to grab ahold of Salvador's right wrist and forcefully pulled his right hand behind his back. As soon as I got Salvador's right hand behind his back, he submitted and complied with my commands to put his left hand behind his back. I placed Salvador in handcuffs and subsequently placed him under arrest for PC 148(a)(1) and PC 166(a)(4). Salvador did not sustain any injuries as a result of the use of force.

While I was dealing with Salvador, Senior Deputy Valdez arrived on scene and subsequently arrested Jeanette for PC 148(a)(1). Refer to Senior Deputy Valdez' supplemental report for further details.

I conducted a record check and determined this was Salvador's sixth time being arrested for violating the court order since 01/26/21. Refer to Crime Report #s 21-11769, 21-13823, 21-18094, 21-19854, and 21-21719 for further details. It should be noted, [REDACTED] was 66 years old at the time, was bound to a wheelchair and had a caretaker, due to multiple medical ailments. I believed Salvador's multiple violations of the court order had caused continuous mental suffering for [REDACTED]. Therefore, I added the additional charge of PC 368(c) to Salvador's charges.

Refer to Sergeant Ponce's supplemental report for Rogelio's statement.

I transported Salvador to the Main Jail, where he was booked for the above stated charges.

I completed an Elder Abuse Report and faxed it to Ventura County Adult Protective Services. Refer to the attached Elder Abuse report for further details. I uploaded my body worn camera footage to [www.evidence.com](http://www.evidence.com).

Sergeant Ponce was on scene and approved of my arrest.

I was familiar with Salvador and the restraining order (Case# 56202100549595). I personally arrested him on 2-9-2021 for violating the terms when I observed him gardening in the front yard of the property (RB# 21-18094). I knew the order prohibited Salvador from contacting [REDACTED] in any way and coming within 100 yards of the address. Prior to arriving, I checked the terms of the order again on my patrol unit's laptop through CLETS (California Law Enforcement Telecommunications System) and confirmed the same terms were still in effect and remained valid until 2-16-2026.

I arrived onscene upon exiting my unit, I heard yelling coming from the inside [REDACTED]'s house as I approached from the street. I entered through the front unlocked door and observed Deputy Glasscock #5248 and Sergeant Ponce #2772 pinning down Salvador on the couch and instructing him to place his hands behind his back. Salvador was refusing to comply and yelling at Deputy Glasscock and Sergeant Ponce.

Salvador's daughter, (A) Jeanette Villanueva, was approximately 12 to 18 inches away from Deputy Glasscock's left side and was yelling at them. Jeanette was attempting to intervene and explain that her father (Salvador) had mental health issues. Jeanette was holding her cell phone in her hand and the back was facing toward Deputy Glascock, Sergeant Ponce, and Salvador.

Deputy Glasscock and Sergeant Ponce were both commanding Jeanette to back up and cease trying to interfere with the arrest. Jeanette said Salvador lived there and was trying to pick up his property. I focused my attention on Jeanette and explained the restraining order to her. I gave her several commands to back up and get away from Deputy Glasscock and Sergeant Ponce. Jeanette refused to listen to me and kept explaining that Salvador used to live at the location. I placed my hands on her shoulders and told her to back up and she responded by physically resisting and maintaining her stance. After speaking to her and further explaining the terms of the order, she backed up a few inches. Jeanette refused my commands to back up further and sit down on a nearby couch.

I turned back to Deputy Glasscock and Sergeant Ponce to assist them with Salvador's arrest. When I walked closer to them, Jeanette walked back toward us and was less than six inches from my body and within arm's reach of Salvador. Jeanette continued to obstruct our efforts at arresting Salvador and continued to yell at us.

At this point, it was apparent Jeanette was not following the numerous simple commands given by all of us to stay away from us so we could arrest Salvador while he actively resisted us. I was unable to assist Deputy Glasscock and Sergeant Ponce and complete this arrest due to Jeanette's actions. Jeannete was clearly obstructing and delaying us in the performance of our duties as we attempted to make a lawful arrest for PC 166(a)(4) Disobey a Court Order.

I made the decision to arrest Jeanette for PC 148(a)(1) Resist, Obstruct, or Delay a Peace Officer. I pushed her back with my hands on her upper arms to create distance between her and my partners. I told Jeanette to place her hands behind her back and she refused. I pushed her back until her back was against a wall. Jeanette faced me and kept her hands at her sides while arguing with me. With Salvador's arrest still not complete and his continued active resistance, I knew I had to take her into custody quickly and then assist Deputy Glasscock and Sergeant Ponce with Salvador.

While against the wall, I pushed Jeanette's right arm by her elbow up with my right hand so it was horizontal with her clavicle and then reached my left arm around the back of her neck. Jeanette dropped her phone and it fell on the ground. I clasped my hands together with a palm to palm grip and squeezed my arms together. I twisted my body to the left and downward. This caused her body to fall to the ground and land on her stomach. I used both of my hands on her right wrist and placed her arm behind her back while Sergeant Ponce instructed her to place her left arm behind her back. Jeanette complied and I placed two pairs of handcuffs on Jeanette due to her large girth.

I escorted Jeanette to my patrol unit and asked her if she was hurt. Jeanette complained of pain to her left arm. I informed Sergeant Ponce of Jeanette's complaint of pain and my intention to take her the Ventura County Medical Center (VCMC) to have the injury evaluated. Sergeant Ponce agreed with my decision and I transported her. While preparing to leave, Jeannette said several times she did not want medical attention and just wanted to get the process over with.

Due to the rapidly evolving situation from my arrival to the use of force, I forgot to activate my body worn camera until after Jeanette was in handcuffs. My body worn camera footage captures Jeanette's escort from the house and to my patrol unit. The footage also includes my conversation with her in the unit where she first complained of the pain to her left arm.

I drove VCMC and she said the pain was localized to her left middle finger. While at the hospital, I took two photos of her left hand and send them to the Sheriff's Photo Lab. X-Rays were taken of the finger it showed there was a very small fracture near the first and second knuckle from the tip of her left middle finger. The doctor said it would heal in two weeks. The doctor taped her middle and ring finger together and called it a "buddy splint." I transported her to the Main Jail and she was booked for PC 148(a)(1) without further incident.

Captain Fazio arrived onscene and was advised of the situation.

## OFFICER'S NARRATIVE

## Source of Activity:

On 02-23-21, I was assigned as the Moorpark Patrol Shift Supervisor working within the city of Moorpark and the unincorporated areas surrounding the city of Moorpark. On this date I was wearing a full Sheriff's uniform and driving a marked black and white Sheriff's S.U.V.

## Sergeant Actions and Observations:

On 02-23-21, at approximately 1621 hours, Deputy Glasscock and I received a call to respond to [REDACTED] in Moorpark reference a violation of an elder / dependent adult abuse restraining order investigation. Dispatch further advised that V-[REDACTED] Villanueva (65 years old) had an active elder / dependent adult abuse restraining order against his brother Sal Villanueva and that Sal was currently at the residence.

I had prior knowledge of this restraining order and know what [REDACTED] Villanueva is confined to a wheelchair and is unable to protect himself or run away from a violent situation if it was needed. The restraining order states that Salvador was to stay 100 yards away from the property. I was the first on scene and noticed the west gate was dummy locked that led up to the property. I also noticed Sal's daughter, later identified as Jeanette Villanueva ([REDACTED]), was near the front door gate but it was locked.

I went over to speak to Jeanette Villanueva and as I was explaining why I was there, Salvador came out of the residence and asked me what I was doing there. Salvador was talking gibberish and I did not know if this was drug induced or if he was having a mental health episode. I attempted to distract / maintain the attention of both Salvador and Jeanette until the secondary officer arrived on scene and could enter through the west gate.

Jeanette told me that [REDACTED] was her property and that I was trespassing. I explained to Jeanette and Salvador why we were there. When Deputy Glasscock arrived to the location I instructed him to enter through the west gate which he did. I then followed Deputy Glasscock onto the property. Jeanette immediately became defensive and told us we could not be on the property, that we were trespassing, and to leave her property. Salvador turned and began walking fast towards the front door of the residence.

At this time I was afraid for the safety of [REDACTED] Villanueva so Deputy Glasscock and I walked past Jeanette and I detained Salvador Villanueva inside the living room of the house. Deputy Glasscock told Salvador to stop and when he kept walking he grabbed him by the shoulders and pushed him onto a couch. I was the cover officer and noticed that Jeanette was coming over and telling us to let her father go. I told Jeanette multiple times to back up and to not touch Deputy Glasscock. Since Deputy Glasscock was still struggling with Salvador and I was preoccupied keeping Jeanette away, I asked for an additional unit through Dispatch. Refer to Deputy Glasscock's report for his actions and eventual arrest of Salvador Villanueva.

Eventually Sr. Deputy Valdez responded to our location and came inside the residence. I asked Sr. Deputy Valdez to hold back Jeanette while we arrested Salvador for a violation of a restraining order. Sr. Deputy Valdez got in between Deputy Glasscock, Salvador, myself and Jeanette. He pushed back Jeanette but she kept trying to interfere with the arrest. Sr. Deputy Valdez took Jeanette to the ground and arrested her for 148(a)(1) P.C. Refer to the supplemental report authored by Sr. Deputy Valdez for additional details regarding the arrest of Jeanette.
